Fifth and Sixth Trumpets

2 Fifth Trumpet - Star and Abyss

(Rev 9:1-12 NIV) The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. The star was given the key to the shaft of the Abyss. {2} When he opened the Abyss, smoke rose from it like the smoke from a gigantic furnace. The sun and sky were darkened by the smoke from the Abyss. {3} And out of the smoke locusts came down upon the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth. {4} They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any plant or tree, but only those people who did not have the seal of God on their foreheads. {5} They were not given power to kill them, but only to torture them for five months. And the agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes a man. {6} During those days men will seek death, but will not find it; they will long to die, but death will elude them. {7} The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. On their heads they wore something like crowns of gold, and their faces resembled human faces. {8} Their hair was like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' teeth. {9} They had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the thundering of many horses and chariots rushing into battle. {10} They had tails and stings like scorpions, and in their tails they had power to torment people for five months. {11} They had as king over them the angel of the Abyss, whose name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek, Apollyon. {12} The first woe is past; two other woes are yet to come.

3 ■ The Star

- Star
 - "had fallen"
 - Apostasy
 - Satan?
- *Interpretation:*
 - political or spiritual leader (or both)
 - fallen, in some sense.

4 The Abyss

- Literally, a shaft
- Christ descending to Hades (1 Peter 3:18-20)
- Demons fate (Luke 8:31)
- Key = Authority
- Beast in Revelation
- Interpretation: Home to Demons

5 Smoke

- Parallel to incense -- except evil
- "Smoke and mirrors"
- Like clouds of locusts, blocking the sun

6 Locusts - the theories

- Literal
 - · Lindsey's mutant demon possessed locusts.
 - Helicopters and nerve gas
 - real locusts (Barclay)
- Figurative (locusts eat grass)

7 Joel 1:4 - 2:10

- Not the same events- but parallel.
- Locusts!
- Lion's teeth
- Trumpets
- Horses
- Prophecy of the Assyrian invasion

8 Historicist View

- Mohammed
 - a fallen prince
 - spiritual and political leader
 - apostasy denial of the Resurrection
- Arabian invasion of Eastern Roman Empire Ad 632-782

9 Locusts

- told not to harm the grass of the earth
 - ...people who did not have the seal of God
 - five months
 - not given power to kill them,
- □ Ordered not to harm any vegetation
 - harm no monastery or church
 - AD 632 782
 - Islam, the tribute or the sword

10 The Arab Warrior

(Rev 9:13-21 NIV) The sixth angel sounded his trumpet, and I heard a voice coming from the horns of the golden altar that is before God. {14} It said to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, "Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates." {15} And the four angels who had been kept ready for this very hour and day and month and year were released to kill a third of mankind. {16} The number of the mounted troops was two hundred million. I heard their number. {17} The horses and riders I saw in my vision looked like this: Their breastplates were fiery red, dark blue, and yellow as sulfur. The heads of the horses resembled the heads of lions, and out of their mouths came fire, smoke and sulfur. {18} A third of mankind was killed by the three plaques of fire, smoke and sulfur that came out of their mouths. {19} The power of the horses was in their mouths and in their tails; for their tails were like snakes, having heads with which they inflict injury. {20} The rest of mankind that were not killed by these plaques still did not repent of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshiping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze,

stone and wood--idols that cannot see or hear or walk. {21} Nor did they repent of

their murders, their magic arts, their sexual immorality or their thefts.

- Angels are "bound"
- Boundary of Roman Empire
- Boundary given to Abraham (Gen 18:15)
- Boundary of Garden
- Turkish Empire
 - 1057
 - 4 sons of Malek Shah

14 hour and day and month and year

- Historicist: time elapsed
 - Greek eniautos, the 365 1/4 day year
 - = 396 years, 4 months
 - January 1057 through 29 May 1453
- Futurist = literal time held
- 15 AD 1075
- 16 AD 1430
- 17 **200 Million**
 - Literally, 200 myriads of myriads.
 - Futurist: literal
 - Lindsey- Chinese
 - Talbot Japanese
 - Historicist
 - Turkish regiment
